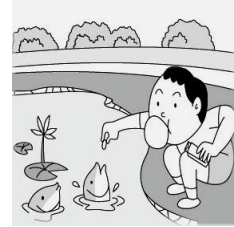
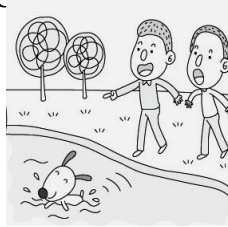

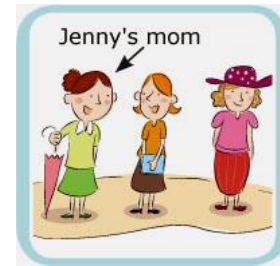

"Super-doctor" Hsu Chao-pin

Hsu Chao-pin was born and grew up in Taitung. When he was just seven years old, one of his younger sisters died because she couldn't get to the hospital in time. That shocked him, so he made up his mind that he wanted to become a doctor. After graduating from the university, he first decided to work in Tainan's Chi Mei Hospital, and then went back to his hometown.

Thanks to his hard work, he was finally able to set up a 24-hour emergency station in Dawu in 2006, but now he still keeps spending a superhuman 400 hours a month working. "Now I've got the more power to provide better medical care and education in southern Taitung. That's something I could have never done before," he said. It's no wonder people call him, "Super-doctor".

Have you ever seen people carrying trash bags while jogging? Or their hands filled with old plastic bottles?


Plogging — it is a mix of the word jogging and the Swedish “plockaupp,” meaning to pick up. In the United States, it’s just starting to get popular for those who like jogging but are unhappy to see garbage.

“I’m not going to just let garbage lie there. I’m not going to just walk past that plastic bottles,” said a plogger, Emily Wright. “I don’t think it’s stupid to pick trash up. But I also think it’s worse for a person that doesn’t take responsibility for it.”

Ms. Wright, 40, has been plogging for several months. Just a few weeks ago, she learned that what she’s been doing has a name. “My friend used to call it my trash runs,” said Wright. She usually picks up cigarettes, plastic bottles and bottle caps.

Plogging can help the Earth, and it’s quite good for your health, too. A half-hour of both jogging and picking up trash will burn 288 calories for a person. That’s more than jogging alone.


A Swedish plogger, Ms. Tesch, 28, said she learned about plogging last year as it got popular in her country. “I run a lot and I love to spend time in nature. When I find trash in the park or on the grass, it makes me sad and angry,” Tesch said in an email. “It’s so easy to pick up trash and put it in the nearest trash can. It makes you feel like you’re making a difference!”
