People first saw frogs and toads 400 million years ago．But do they have a future？Scientists from all over the world are trying to answer this question．They came up with a plan that is one big leap to save these animals．This means frogs and toads need our help，or they may die out．

Frogs and toads are amphibians．Amphibians are cold－blooded animals．They live on both land and in water． That means they can jump on roads and swim in water．Frogs and toads are in the same family，but they are different in many ways．Frogs have long strong legs，but toads have short ones．Frogs have strong legs for jumping，but toads have strong legs for walking．Because frogs need to keep their back wet，they live near water．Toads have dry backs， so they live on land．

It＇s easy to hear frogs sing．However，it＇s difficult to hear toads sing．Frogs have teeth，but toads have no teeth． Both of them like to eat small fish，spiders，and many other small insects．Most frogs are lively in daytime，but toads sleep in daytime and are lively at night．Both frogs and toads live alone．That means they don＇t like to live with their family and friends．

Many kinds of frogs are going to be gone．A study in 2004 found that almost 2000 kinds of amphibians were hard to find．Several things could be hurting amphibians，for example，cutting down many trees and polluting water． In Washington，D．C．，scientists have a plan to help amphibians．It＇s not easy to save amphibians．But there is hope． ＂We still have time to take action，＂says Claude Gascon of the World Conservation Union．
