The idea may hit you once or twice a year. You come home on a hot summer day, hoping to have a cool bath, and find out there is no water. Then you see 30. However, in many parts of the world, water is not just about one's everyday needs.

In countries like Tanzania, water is hard to get, and the job of collecting water falls on women's shoulders. Girls are often kept home from school to collect water while their brothers stay at school studying. Studies show Tanzanian girls who live 15 minutes from clean water spend 12% more time at school than those who live an hour away. More time spent collecting water means 31. For these girls, "Knowledge is power" is not just words; it is a sad fact in real life. With less time spent at school, their chances of getting well-paid jobs are small, and they often have no voice in important matters, like who to marry. These girls are often married into poor families. They have little money or knowledge to take care of their children, who often end up dying young. For the baby girls who are lucky enough to live, their life may still center around "32," just like it did for their mothers.

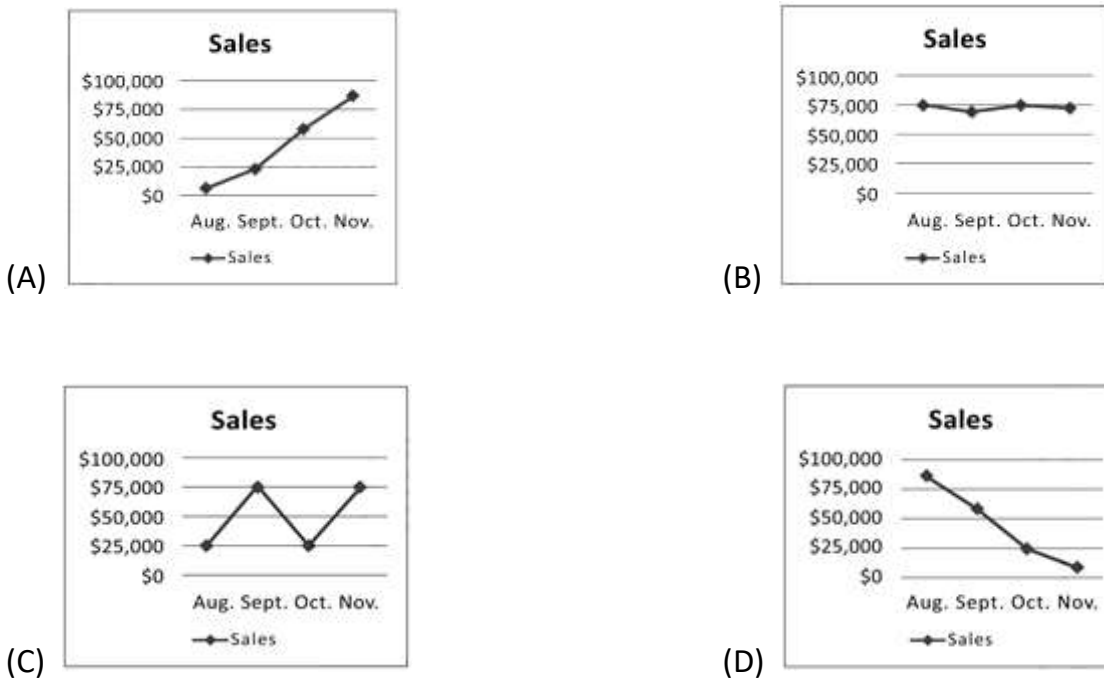

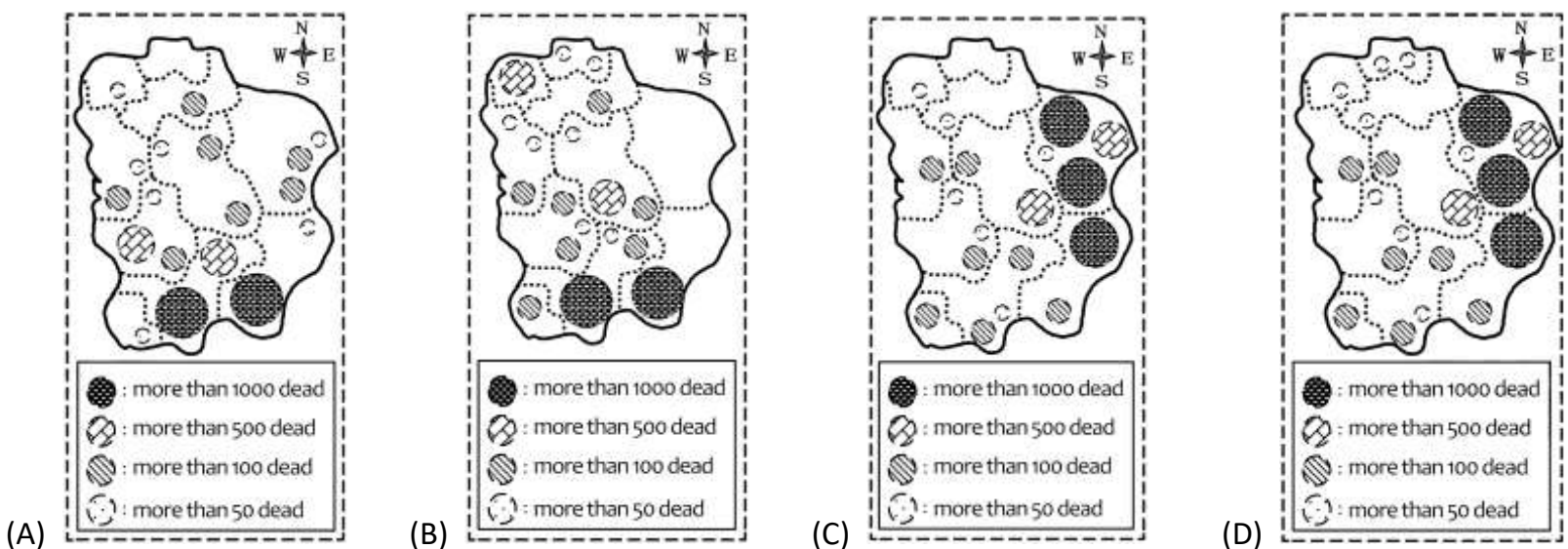

### *The Hidden Meanings of Colors*


It is said different colors carry different meanings. When people have something to ask for, they may wear clothes with the “right” color, hoping this could be helpful for their wishes to come true. How to choose the right color? Here are some interesting facts.

Red is the color of fire. It brings people joy and love. That may tell you why this color is favored by actresses. Black stands for one’s health. It can make our minds and bodies stronger. Some people even believe wearing black stones can make them live longer.

Green brings people happiness. It is also the sign of peace. When talking about green, we may think of trees, grass or mountains. Those things make us feel comfortable and safe. Blue helps people to speak well, so it’s quite popular with teachers and reporters. It also means wisdom. But interestingly, when we say someone is blue, in our eyes that person looks sad, not smart. People feel less hungry when they see the color, so it’s seldom seen in restaurants.

Yellow is the color that can be noticed easily. You may have already “noticed” that in Taiwan, taxis are painted yellow. But because it’s a bright color, people get nervous when yellow is around. The study shows this color is too “jumpy” to be used in baby’s room--- babies cry more often in rooms with yellow walls.

If you still think choosing the “right” color is too troubling, just pick the color that looks good on you. After all, what really matters is whether you feel comfortable with it.

## Cotton Candy – A Sweet Full of Surprises

Cotton candy has lit up children's eyes for the past hundreds of years. Now it still gives us lots of surprises. Here is one example: Are there any sweets that can be used for medical purposes? Cotton candy can be! Although many people don't think it is possible, scientists are already working on it!


Cotton candy was first made in Italy in the 1400s. Because it took a long time and needed a lot of people to get it done, it's not wallet-friendly at all. However, in 1897, the price of cotton candy finally fell down because two people. William Morrison and John Wharton, found a different way to make it. They made it with a machine which saved them a lot of time and money. When they presented their work at the 1904 World's Fair in the United States, they sold more than 68,000 boxes of cotton candy. They gave cotton candy a wonderful future!

Cotton candy gives children not only joy but also knowledge. Science teachers can use cotton candy to show students how centrifugal force works while making it. It is much easier for kids to learn if they can really face the machine and experience how it works.

For medical purposes, some scientists believe one day cotton candy will be used to make little pipes for blood to run through. Of course, there is still a long way to go, but at least it gives us hope.

So next time when you see cotton candy placed in a shop or snacks stand, don't think of it as just a sweet. One day, it may be used to save your life.
