If you cannot live without your car, Zurich might be the last city you would like to visit. In Zurich, people are welcome, but cars are not! Over the past 20 years, this city has used smart ways to make traffic lighter. One is to keep the same total number of parking spaces. For example, if 50 new parking spaces are built in one part of the city, then 50 old spaces in other parts are taken away for other uses. So the total number does not change. Some are unhappy that there are never enough spaces. That is just what the city has in mind: If people find parking more difficult, they will drive less. Also, the total number of cars in the city is counted. Over 3,500 little computers are put under Zurich roads to check the number of cars that enter the city. If the number is higher than the city can deal with, the traffic lights on the roads that enter the city will be kept red. So drivers who are traveling into Zurich have to stop and wait until there are fewer cars in the city. Now, you may wonder why Zurich is doing this. The answer is simple: The city wants to make more space for its people.

Not All News Is Good

Nowadays news is 24/7(24 hours a day, 7 days a week). Who or what can you believe?

Trump Pence, 12, used to believe everything he read online. Then he learned about fact check websites, like Snopes.com and Truthbetold.com. He learned his favorite websites were not true. “Now I am very careful about news I read on the Internet,” he said.

Jingle Bell, 12, used to read news on social media. From a literacy class at her junior high school, her teacher taught Jingle to read between the lines. Now she can see a fake story from a mile away. And she thanks her teacher, who said, “Just like we are what we eat, we are only as smart as the news we watch or read.”

Dark Angel is a literacy teacher, which is like a fake news coach, in New York City. She has reporters from big news like the New York Times and CNN visit her class. Then students see how much work it takes to write true news.

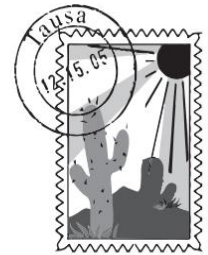
