Most of the time there are 12 busses a day (every 10 minutes) to and from your areas for the school travel times, which are 7-8 A.M. and 3-4 P.M.

Hide from the Russians and Read a Book at the Same Time in Ukraine's Libraries.

Libraries are front line in the Ukraine-Russia War, and sadly, so are schools, hospitals, and many other public buildings.

"It's really scary when schools, libraries, universities, hospitals, baby hospitals, people's houses are bombed," Oksana Brui, who is the president of the Ukrainian Library Association (ULA), told NPR.

It's also really scary when your country is taken over for no reason. Russia first fought Ukraine on February 24. The first bombs hit army buildings and communications. Then Russian soldiers tried to come into Ukraine and take over big cities like Kyiv. When this didn't work, Russia began to bomb all public buildings from schools to hospitals.

You might think libraries close in a big war. But Ukraine libraries are busier than ever. They fight the information war with Russia, telling the truth about why Putin is wrong. They keep the Ukrainian language and culture. They are a safe building from bombs. And libraries even make war things.

Unfortunately, public buildings are not doing too well in Ukraine right now. The famous Chernihiv Library was bombed on March 12. A Mariupol theater, full of women and children, was bombed on March 18. The Russians knew children were inside!

Henry is a famous painter in art history. Like Monet, Cezanne, or Renoir, Matisse is a national hero in France. Two of his best paintings are *The Woman with a Hat* and *The Dinner Table*. He lived a long, long life. He was friends with Picasso. And Matisse's paintings have sold for 20 million dollars. Still, Matisse had both an easy and a hard life

First, the Hard Part

Matisse was born on December 31, 1869 to a good family, so he was never poor. But, his father was very, very strict, or serious. Maybe this is why Matisse had to study law and not art. His father wanted a law job, not an art one. But, Matisse got sick right after finishing school. He had to stay in bed for one year.

Second, the Easy Part

Suddenly, even though he was sick, Matisse's life got really good. His mother, who was nicer than his father, bought him some art things so he could paint in bed. She helped him to paint from his feelings and make his own style. And, oh, boy, did Matisse ever go his own way!

Matisse is the father of Fauvism, a very colorful painting style. He also painted several masterpieces, formed his own art school in Paris, became one of the biggest painters of the 1900's, and sold his paintings for a lot of money.

Was his father proud of Matisse? Nobody knows.
